Salvation Army – Just to let you know that our Club has donated \$500.00 to the Salvation Army towards food hampers for the Ipswich Community this Christmas.

Club Visits 2025 – Regarding our proposed visit to Elderflower Farm on <u>21 March 2025</u> – I have spoken to Rachel at the Elderflower farm, and she says that while happy to do the farm tour for us, the end of March is coming towards the end of their summer flower season. So members decided at our last meeting, we'd do that visit later in the year and organise a visit to the Mt Coot-tha Botanical Gardens for a guided tour instead and incorporate their new Dahlia Display Garden into the day which will be in full bloom then. Show Schedules – The Show schedules are being updated, particulartly the Dahlia section. I will prepare a complete new draft for consideration by the Committee prior to the start of February for benching. Guest Speaker/Judges for 2025 – President Sandra and I are busily arranging Guest Speakers and Judges for the New Year. While we have great Judges at our Shows we have asked Helen (M) to prepare a sort of "Direction for Judges" – incorporating some questions that they may like to address to help us all learn a little more on presenting our exhibits for showing.

Floral Art for 2025 – We have asked Helen (M) to consult with Dawn to prepare a new floral art schedule for the New Year for us.

Lucky Door 2025 – I have noone to bring a lucky door for the first meeting in February – I'd like two volunteers please - if you want to bring a lucky door, something to the value of \$20.00, please let me know, and I will put your name down on my roster for February 8, which is our first meeting for the new year.

IHSI Club Constitution – Our current Constitution in its "Objects" should have (for the purpose of obtaining Grants) that our Club is "not for profit". As it currently stands, that is not incorporated into our "Objects" in our Constitution, remembering our Club goes way back. There are two ways to solve this and this was the subject of much discussion also at our last meeting. It was therefore agreed that the easiest option would be that our Club adopt the new version of the Model Rules¹ available on the OFT website. So in January you will all receive from me – a copy of the current Club Constitution and then a copy of the proposed Model Rules, for final decision at the AGM.

AGM – As you know <u>8 March</u> is our AGM. Please consider nominating for a postion on our Committee. The AGM is always short and our Patron Concillor Madden will oversee the proceedings. There will be a guest speaker thereafter and as usual our benches will be full of exhibits ready for our first Show of the season. Our Judge wil be Helen Murray.

Membership Fees will also be due. \$15.00 and if you would like you newsletter posted (the additional postage will apply). Alternatively, please give the secretary your email details if she doesn't already have it. Please continue to encouragte new people to our club/meetings. I shall be in touch in the new year closer to our meeting to give you all a reminder of this that and the other.
