The Plant & Floral Fair is the major event in the QCGC calendar. The show is for the benefit of all QCGC member clubs as it provides

- ✓ an excellent opportunity to promote your club/society
- ✓ showcases spectacular exhibits on the competition bench
- ✓ gives interested gardeners access to gardening information
- ✓ provides funds for QCGC to use for the betterment of its members.

All QCGC member clubs are encouraged to participate. There are several areas where this can be achieved.

1 MEMBER CLUB STALLS

- Clubs may have a stall to sell plants (named, well established and pest & disease free, National Fire Ant Eradication Program compliant), craft, or home-made goods e.g. cakes, sweets, preserves or other items (no used items).
- The stall site is free; two tables & two chairs are provided.
- A donation of 10% on items sold will be payable to QCGC at the end of the show.
- Volunteers that staff the stall must be registered for complimentary entry – (up to 5 people per day).
- Tea/coffee station available for registered stall volunteers only.
- Bump in: Thursday 9 April from 11am. Bump out: Saturday after 3pm.
- No limit to number of volunteers.

2 COMPETITION BENCH DISPLAY

- Clubs may promote their group with a display.
- Display to be judged - Category 5 in the Schedule.
- Complimentary entry for up to 5 volunteers per day to staff the display if required.
- Volunteers must be registered to receive complimentary entry.
- Tea/coffee station - complimentary tea, coffee, and biscuits available for registered Volunteers only.

3 COMPETITION BENCH PRIZES

- Clubs may donate a prize (voucher, or money – direct deposit) up to \$20 for the winners in a class.

4 REFRESHMENTS

- An opportunity exists for a club raise funds by managing the refreshments at the Plant & Floral Fair
- Club will be responsible for providing refreshments in line with QCGC guidelines.
- Offerings include sandwiches, cake or slice, tea and coffee.
- Pricing will be agreed in consultation with QCGC Management
- The club will purchase all supplies and prepare food in accordance with Standard Practices.
- All proceeds are retained by the club as a fundraising benefit
- The club may provide own club volunteers to staff or volunteers may come from other clubs.
